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**S 012. MILITARY EXERCISE "IRON WOLF II"****1. General**

During the period **12 October – 23 October 2021** a multinational military exercise IRON WOLF II will be conducted in the Vilnius FIR/UIR of the Republic of Lithuania.

The military exercise will be conducted in airspaces published in ENR 5.1 of Lithuania AIP and in addition temporary established segregated area TESA274. Details can be found in paragraph 2.1

Restriction apply to non-participating traffic.

All times are in UTC.

**2. Exercise areas****2.1. Temporary established segregated area**

Planned use is specified in paragraph 4 and daily via AUP/UUP.

No flight planning buffer zone (FBZ) is established for temporary established segregated area.

The temporary segregated area description is below:

**3. Restrictions**

For the temporary established segregated area defined in paragraph 2.1, the following temporary EU (FUA) restriction will be published:

EUEYTS274R - Not available for traffic.

The restrictions will not be applicable to the following flights/ aircraft: military aircraft participating in the exercises, border guard, police, search and rescue aircraft, firefighting services, emergency medical assistance services, provided that their flights within the exercise airspace are coordinated in advance and necessary due to assignments allocated to their institutions.

#### 4. Airspace activation schedule

Note: Actual area activity hours (restrictions) will be promulgated daily, day prior exercise by NOTAM's and AUP/UUP.

Exercise area bookings will be executed via Military AMC. The Military AMC will submit area bookings following the established procedures to Airspace Management Cell (AMC) by e-mail: amc@ans.lt until 08.00 UTC within at least one working day prior to the commencement of the operations.

#### 5. Management of the areas

The exercise areas will be managed daily via AUP/UUP.

NOTAMs will be also published for the activation of the areas as stated in paragraph 2.1 and Lithuania AIP ENR 5.1.

#### 6. Flight planning information for participating traffic

Participating flights to and from the exercise area will be conducted according to flight plans (FPLs) and will have the remark "IRONWOLF" in field 18.

#### 7. Flight planning information for non-participating traffic

During area activation, flight planning through exercise areas for non-participating traffic are not allowed or allowed according to the exemptions described in paragraph 3. Real unavailability of ATS route segments, DCTs, FRA and airspace concerned will be notified via EAUP/EUUP. The corresponding restrictions will be activated for flight planning purposes.

The flights in order to ensure public order, also aircraft participating in the real air policing mission, border guard, police, search and rescue aircraft, firefighting services, emergency medical assistance services, provided that their flights within the exercise areas are necessary due to assignments allocated to their institutions are not restricted to enter active exercise areas/airspace. Entry/ crossing of area is possible only after prior permission. Permission must be coordinated in advance with the military exercise coordinator and appropriate civil ATC unit (APP or ACC).

#### 8. Communication/Notification

The Aircrews participating in the IRON WOLF II exercises, executing flights in controlled airspace outside the exercise area should conduct them in accordance with GAT flight rules and SERA requirements, also should maintain radio communication by VHF radio with the appropriate civil ATC.

The Aircrews participating in the exercise, executing the flights within activated exercise areas shall maintain radio communication with the respectful military control unit (MCU). MCU frequency: main 336,150 MHz, back-up 138,175 MHz.

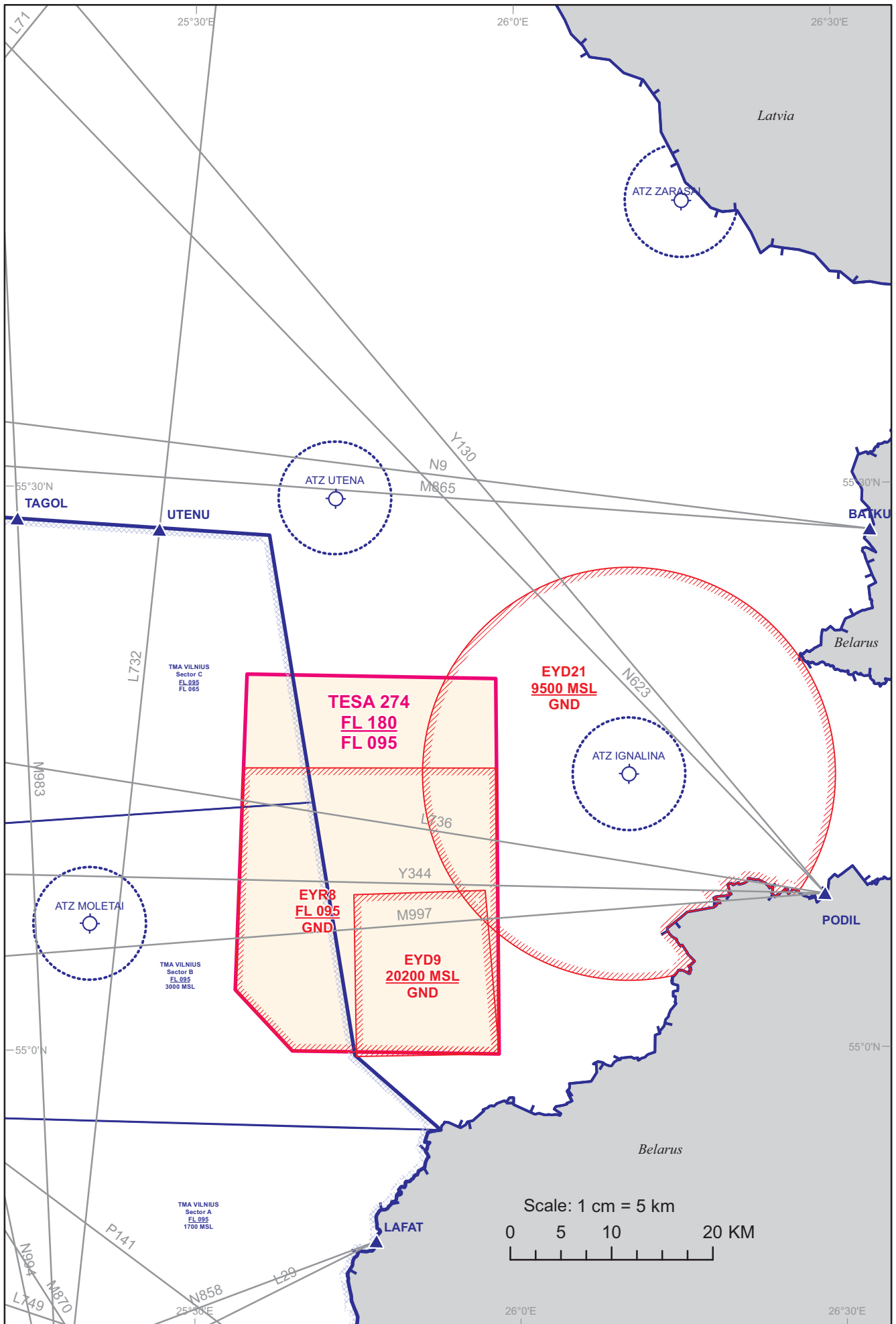
